OPTIONAL ACTIVITIES

Heads or Tails?

Give the children different scenarios and ask them to contribute ways to respond according to the coin flip:
Heads - "I care" Tails - "I Don't care"

- Someone has hurt themselves in the Playground
- Someone is stuck with their work
- Someone has lost their shoe
- Someone dropped some litter
- Someone is being bullied

NB. though children might suggest discouragable ideas, the important thing is the opportunity to think around the topic

History Lesson

Split the Bubble into pairs/groups. Give 'person A' 30 - 60 seconds to tell their history (eg: I was born in/on..., I come from..., we used to..., I loved...). When the time is up, Person 'B'(C/D etc) retells what they can remember. Repeat this process until everyone has had a chance to tell their story.

Whose story!?

Ask the children to retell the story of the Good footballer from the perspective of different characters. Consider: Are they the same story, or different stories?

Alternatively pick a different story
